4. **Objectives:**

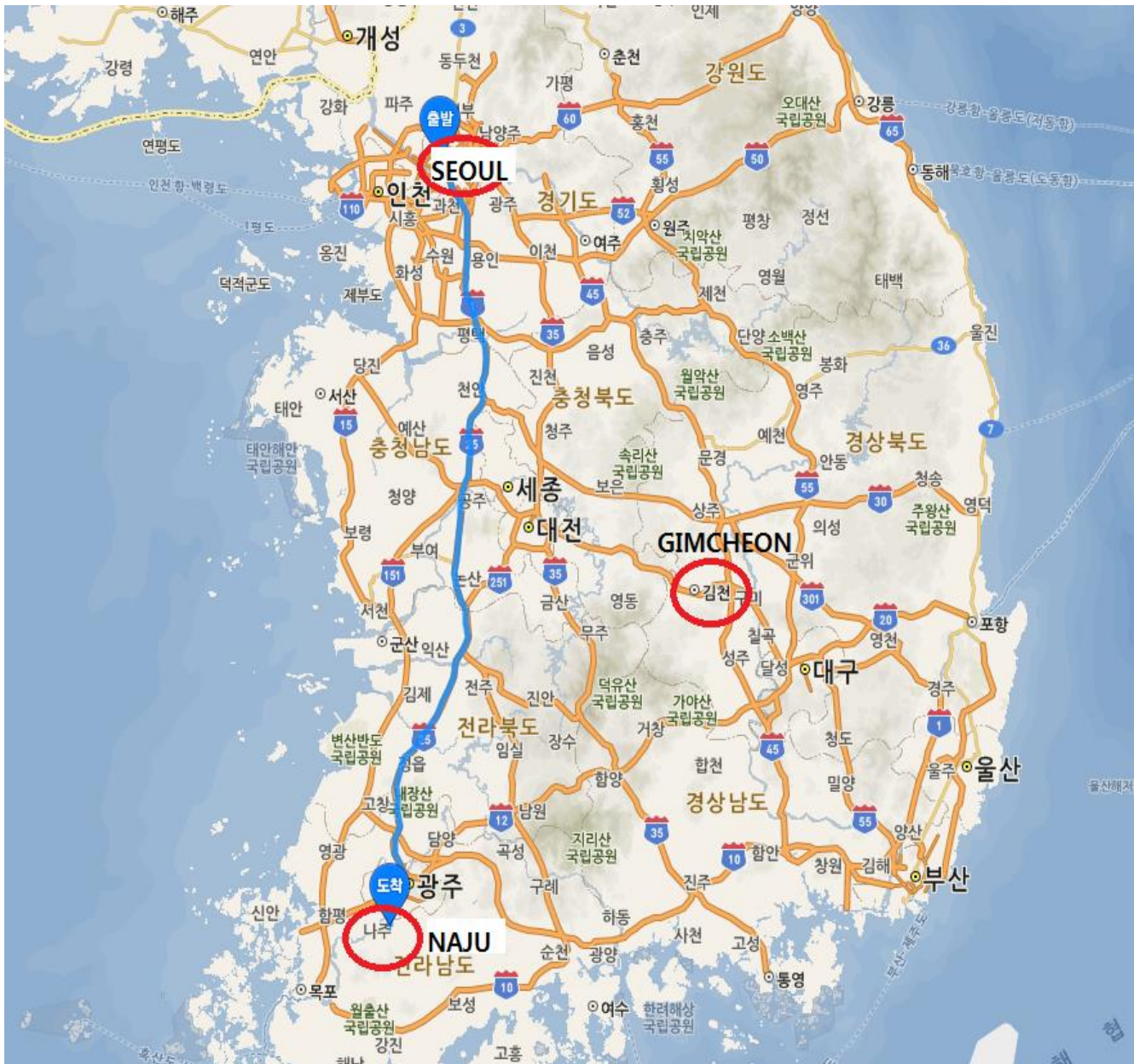
- To enhance knowledge and understanding of agricultural sector sharing Korean experiences

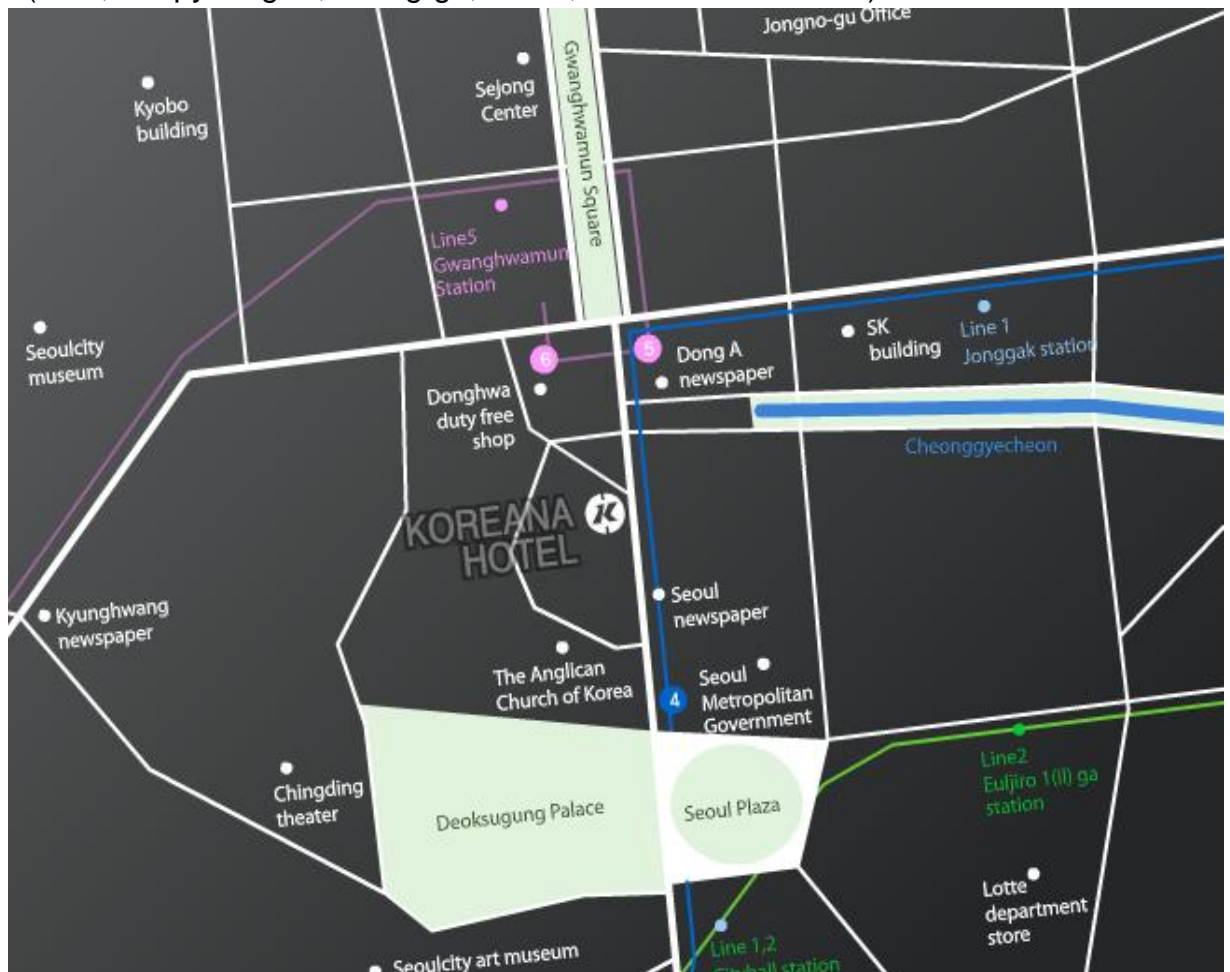

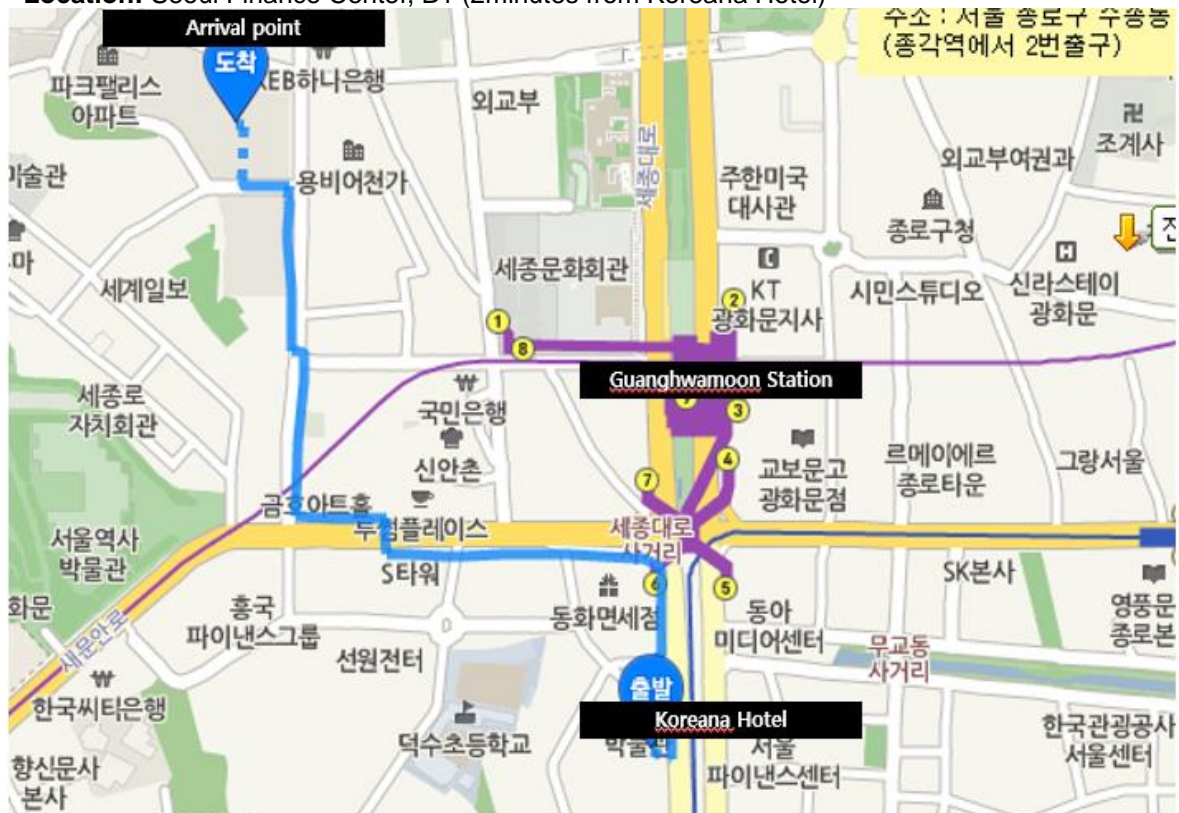


5. Sabal (Noodle)
