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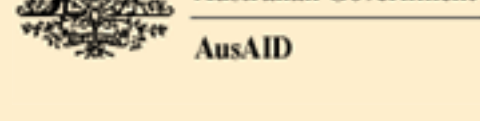
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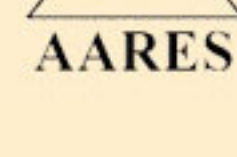

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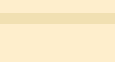
Contributed Papers deadline extended to November 30!

Submission Deadlines

30 November 2005 – Contributed Papers

In response to popular demand, the deadline for Contributed Papers has been extended for one month. The new deadline for submission of Contributed Papers is Wednesday 30 November 2005.

Please note that **full papers must be submitted before this deadline** to qualify for selection for the conference program and to be eligible for fellowships and other financial support.

After acceptance decisions are announced (by about March 6, 2006), authors will be offered an opportunity (up to April 30, 2006) to revise their papers and submit final versions for inclusion in AgEcon Search, the Conference Proceedings CD ROM, and on the IAAE website.

15 December 2005 – Mini-Symposia and Discussion Groups

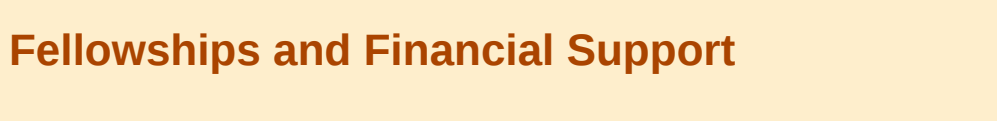

After acceptance decisions are announced (by about March 6, 2006), authors of accepted Poster Papers will then have until April 30, 2006 if they wish to submit a final version of the Poster Paper text, to be included in AgEcon Search as well as the Conference Proceedings CD ROM and on the IAAE website.

Fellowships and Financial Support

The Australian Agricultural and Resource Economics Society (AARES) will offer more than 20 **AARES Fellowships** to support participation of AARES members in the IAAE 2006 conference. Details on how to apply, the selection criteria, and other aspects of these fellowships may be found on the AARES web page <http://come.to/aares>. The web page also has information on how to join AARES.

As in the past, IAAE will make an effort to raise other **financial support for colleagues from developing countries and transforming economies** whose Contributed Papers are accepted for presentation. Authors who are eligible for and in need of such assistance should indicate their desire to be considered for support when making their submission (see www.iaae2006.org for details).

In addition, other organisations will be offering various fellowships to help defray costs of attending the IAAE 2006 conference. Some of these fellowships, like the IAAE support, will be dedicated to colleagues from developing countries and transforming economies.

Some other fellowships will be dedicated to support students to participate. The [Giannini Foundation](#) has announced four fellowships for currently enrolled students from the University of California (\$1,500 each) and the [Center for International Food and Agricultural Policy](#) has announced two fellowships (\$1,500 each) for currently enrolled students from the University of Minnesota. We hope others will follow suit.

Further details on fellowships will be published through issues of this e-newsletter as information becomes available. In most cases the fellowship support will be contingent on having submitted a Contributed Paper or having a Contributed Paper on the program, so it is important to **submit Contributed Papers now to be assured of eligibility for fellowships**.



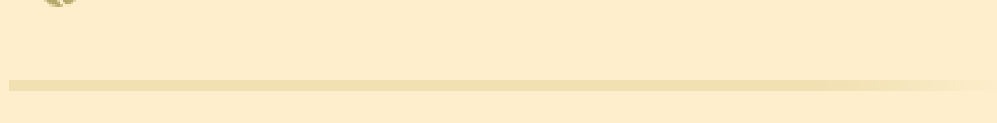

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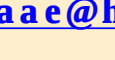
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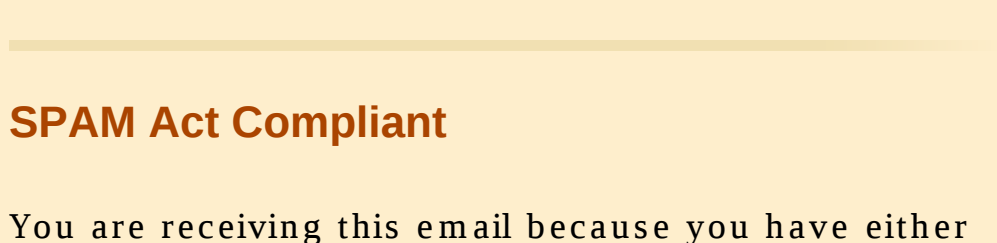
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
